







# Taylor's Shuttle Champ

Impact Report 2024

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## Introduction & Objective

A dynamic collaboration with DuoSparks brought forth an unforgettable experience to an underserved community. The Taylor's Shuttle Champ Badminton Clinics, designed to empower and inspire, used sports psychology to build emotional resilience in its participants as it opened doors to exploring career pathways in badminton. The two-day clinic was held in December 2024 at Sunway X Park, engaging 30 participants comprising of a diverse mix of young locals and refugees. Participants honed their technique, motor skills, communication, and accuracy through 4 hours of training daily, and they also took part in a 1.5 hour workshop on sports psychology and emotional well-being.





#### **DIVISIONS SEGREGATION**

During the two classes, Duo Sparks' coaches assessed all 29 participants to gauge their proficiency and skill levels in badminton. Recognizing a significant disparity in experience among the participants, the coaches recommended dividing them into two divisions. Division 1 comprises experienced and more skilled players, whereas Division 2 primarily consists of beginners and casual players.

#### **CATEGORIES SEGREGATION**

In order to provide every participant with multiple game-playing opportunities, we implemented group stages and a round-robin approach in both divisions. Division 1 is Single Court. Interestingly, Division 2 engages in a unique half-court format for single-player matches, intensifying the competition and enhancing the enjoyment factor. Altogether, two categories were contested in the event.

## In general, this program achieved our overall agreed objective:

- 1.To educate and provide opportunities to our beneficiaries in pursuing career as professionals in Badminton.
- 2. Promoting healthy lifestyles in our communities through sports.
- 3.As a platform to expand our participants pool for our next projects targeting youth

#### **PRE EVENT**

- Registration at the first place was a bit slow but getting better reaching the deadline.
- Planning and communication with Coach Daphne was smooth and she is really helpful in arranging the modules
- We have to reach out our past participants and alumni from CSR programme to increase number of participants.

#### **DURING EVENT**

- 29 participants registered and came for both classes
- However, only 28 participants were coming to the tournament day.
- Few parents request to organise other sports related class for the adults
- Volunteers were very committed and helpful throughout the program. Some provide extra initiative to find sponsors

#### **POST EVENT**

- Impact measurement responses from participants are slow since they have no commitment anymore
- Request received from participants and volunteers for next sport related program
