SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

A total of 26 participants of the International Women's Day Celebration were gathered at Taylor's University UniSquare for the BollyX Workout session. The session was led by an experienced fitness coach, Coach Ben. The participants had a 45-minute workout to Bollywood hit songs. This session was conducted to promote an active lifestyle among the participants.

The participants were then brought to Lecture Theatre 12 for breakfast and a forum session. The forum entitled Emotional Management in Digital Era was moderated by Taylor's Community member featuring 2 esteemed speakers: Yuzila Yusof, a certified trainer, and Nadia Halim, a social media influencer. 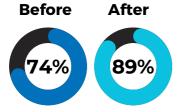

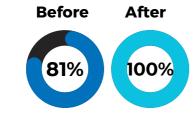
IMPACT ANALYSIS

Participants enjoyed BollyX **Workout session**



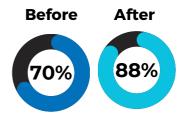
Participants are now aware that they may use social media to find information
